MENTORED RESEARCH TRAINING GRANT

Eligibility:

Faculty members who have completed their core anesthesiology residency training within the past 10 years

Research Areas:

All areas of research that contribute to advances in patient care and can lead to sustained extramural research will be considered

Purpose:

To help anesthesiologists develop the skills and preliminary data to become independent investigators

Funding:

\$250,000

Duration:

Two years

Percent of Research Time:

75%

February 15 and August 15

RESEARCH FELLOWSHIP GRANT

Eligibility:

Anesthesiology trainee after CA-1 year

Research Areas:

Basic science, clinical, translational, health services or education research

Purpose:

To provide significant training in research techniques and scientific methods

Funding:

\$75,000

Duration:

One year

Percent of Research Time:

80%

Application Deadline

February 15 and August 15

RESEARCH IN EDUCATION GRANT

Eligibility:

Faculty member of any rank (junior or senior faculty)

Research Areas:

Education research

Purpose:

To improve the quality and effectiveness of anesthesiology education research

Funding:

\$100,000

Duration:

Two years

Percent of Research Time:

40%

Application Deadline

February 15 and August 15

TRANSITION TO INDEPENDENCE GRANT

Eligibility:

Previous MRTG recipient who completed work on FAER grant within the past two years, and has applied for but not received NIH R-level funding or equivalent

Research Areas:

Basic science, clinical, translational or health services research

Purpose:

To support the transition of investigators from mentored training-focused support to independent (non-mentored) research support

Funding:

\$75,000

Duration:

One year

Percent of Research Time:

75%

Application Deadline

GEMSSTAR GRANT

Eligibility:

New Investigators with R03 GEMSSTAR awards from the National Institute of Aging

Research Areas:

All research topics related to aging and funded by the National Institute of Aging (NIA)

Purpose:

To supplement the 2-year NIA scientific awards with support for simultaneous career development activities

Funding:

\$50,000

Duration:



APSF-FAER Mentored Research Training Grant

The Anesthesia Patient Safety Foundation (APSF) and Foundation for Anesthesia Education and Research (FAER) offer a co-sponsored Mentored Research Training Grant to fund patient safety research directly related to the perioperative care of patients, as well as chronic pain and critical care medicine. Those interested in pursuing the APSF-FAER MRTG will need to submit a Letter of Intent (LOI) prior to submitting a full application.

Anesthesiologist faculty member who is within 10 years of their first faculty appointment

Research Areas:

Patient Safety

Purpose:

To help anesthesiologists develop the skills and preliminary data they need to become independent investigators in the field of anesthesia patient safety

Funding:

\$300,000

Percent Research Time:

60%

Duration:

Two years

LOI Deadline:

Letters of Intent (LOIs) accepted until January 1, 2021

AHA-FAER Career Development Award

The American Heart Association (AHA) and the Foundation for Anesthesia Education and Research (FAER) have teamed to offer the joint AHA-FAER Career Development Award (CDA) to develop the next generation of physician-scientists in anesthesiology conducting cardiovascular and/or cerebrovascular disease related research. While standard AHA CDAs are comprised of \$231,000 in funding, FAER contributed an additional \$19,000 to this co-sponsored grant to bring the total funding for the AHA-FAER CDA to \$250,000 over a three-year period.

Eligibility:

Anesthesiologists holding an MD or DO

Research Areas:

Cardiovascular and/or cerebrovascular disease related research

Purpose:

Support highly promising anesthesiologists, in the early years of one's first professional appointment, to explore innovative questions or pilot studies that will provide preliminary data and training necessary to assure the applicant's future success as a research scientist

Funding:

\$250,000

Percent Research Time:

Minimum of 50%

Duration:

Three years

Application Deadline

February 16, 2021
